Description: This is from the only set of "blue" lobby cards known to exist from this title. Blue lobby sets were made for some of Paramount's major productions in 1931-1932 and only a few of these cards have shown up over the years.

For fans of this classic film or for Dietrich, this represents a rare opportunity to acquire this unique card! The bottom edge has a slight tear, and the upper left-hand corner has a pinhole.

Description: This style "D" one sheet is folded with very little fold wear but two separations at crease points. There are what appear to be two small scorch or burn marks and a tear at the top center seam. The color is outstanding, highlighted by the image of Dietrich in a brass bustiere.

Dietrich glows in stone lithography, and she's especially luminous against an elegant black background.
